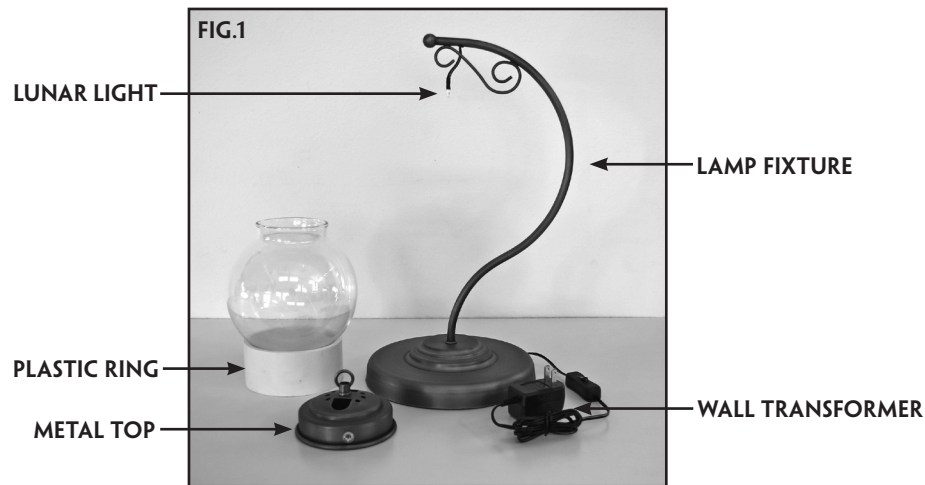
AQUARIUM INSTALLATION

Congratulations on purchasing the first ever suspended aquarium desk lamp. The AquaBetta is a simple, yet elegant aquarium perfect for displaying your favorite Betta Fish. Proper assembly and care will ensure years of tranquility and beauty.

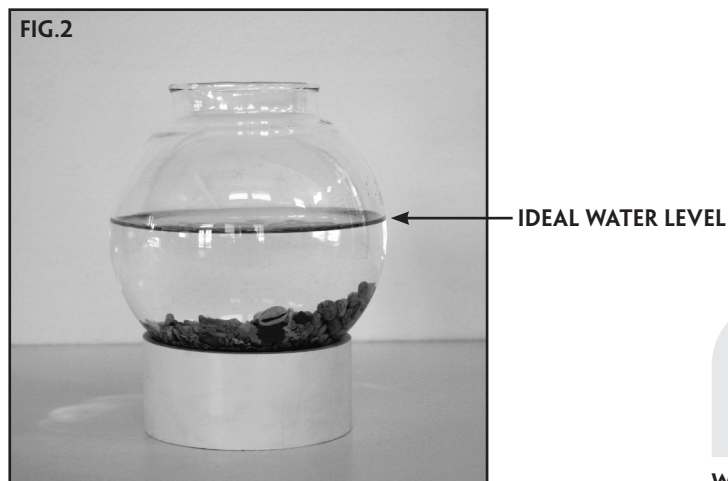
OTHER ITEMS YOU WILL NEED TO COMPLETE THE AQUABETTA:

- Gravel
- Small silk or plastic plant
- Dechlorinator (water conditioner)
- Betta food

1. Carefully unpack the lamp fixture and the metal top, do not unpack the glass bowl at this time. Check the fixture to ensure there is no damage. Place the fixture on the location you have chosen as the best for your AquaBetta, make sure it is on a flat level surface. See Fig.1
2. Locate the plastic ring supplied in the package and place on a flat surface. The plastic ring will be used during the decoration process and will be used whenever you service the aquarium. (Keep the plastic ring even after assembly)



3. Next, carefully unpack the glass aquarium and place on the plastic ring. This will allow you to decorate the aquarium without tipping it over (see Fig.2). Rinse the glass bowl, gravel and decorations thoroughly. Place items in the bowl as you will want them displayed. Add bottled water or filtered tap water (not distilled water) to the glass bowl. Fill to the level shown in Fig. 2, filling to this line provides the best viewing. Add dechlorinator as per instructions and let stand for 15 minutes. Place the betta's bag/cup in the water and allow it to float for 15 minutes and then release the betta into the bowl.

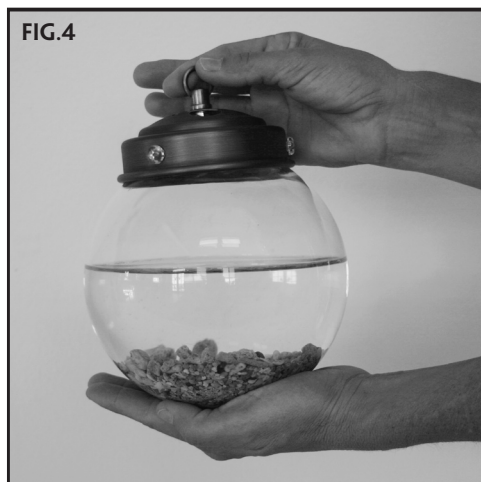

4. Locate the metal top and place on the aquarium. See Fig.3 With a Phillips screw driver or with your fingers tighten the three plastic screws to secure the metal top to the aquarium. Tighten snug, but do not over tighten. With your fingers grasp the ring and lift the aquarium to see that it is attached sufficiently.

5. You are ready to attach the aquarium to the fixture. With both hands remove the aquarium from the plastic ring, move one hand under the aquarium as shown in Fig.4. With the other hand navigate the Lunar light down into the hole of the metal top. See Fig.5 Attach the aquarium to the fixture with the ring and hook. You are now ready to enjoy.

BETTA CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Feed betta once daily with the recommended amount of the betta food you have purchased. Do not overfeed.
- The bowl should be cleaned one time per week, doing a 100% water change. Do not use any type of soap or cleaner, only use hot water. Replace with water by following installation step 3.
- Male bettas should be the only fish in the tank. Do not mix male bettas as they will fight.
- Do not set the AquaBetta in direct sunlight as this will cause unwanted algae growth.
